- 5. Offered cardiac risk screening for every child over 14 at Raiders and at Ashlyns.



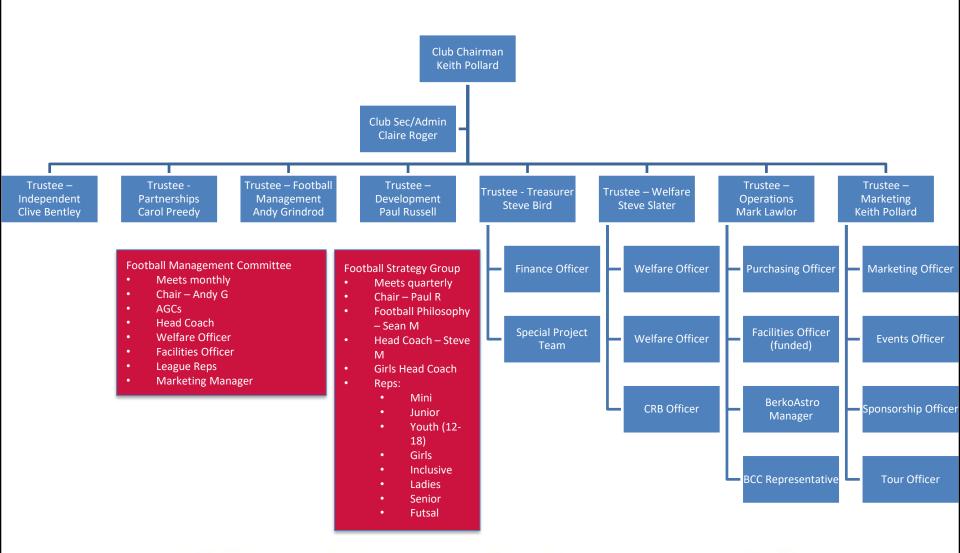
10 things we've done!

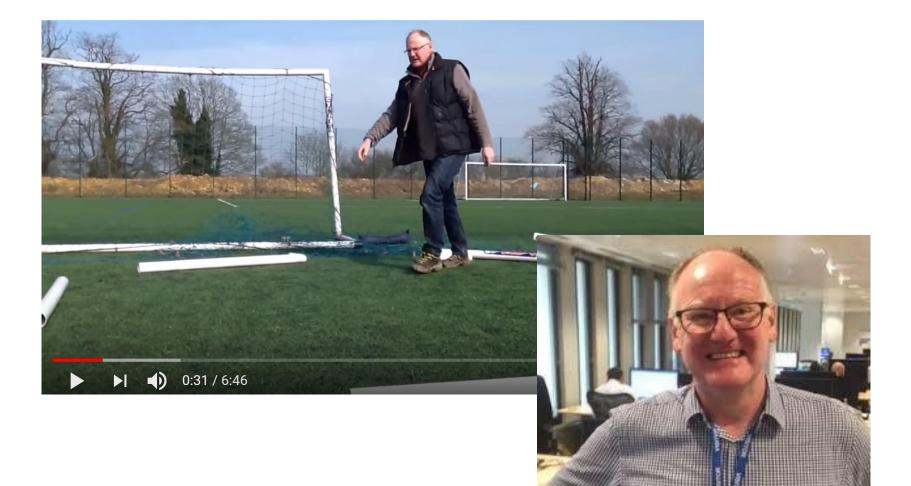

Actual Vs Budget

• INCOME

- We generated £41,534 more than we budgeted (13%)
 - We had more boys and girls playing
 - We raised more grants.
 - BerkoAstro is a success and generated additional funds.

• EXPENDITURE

- We spent £13,705 more than we budgeted (5%)
 - The end of season presentation cost us more.
 - Managers expenses and fines cost us more than we planned.
 - Coaching cost us more, but we coached more children and increased coaching input (girls).

- Successful start to 2018/19

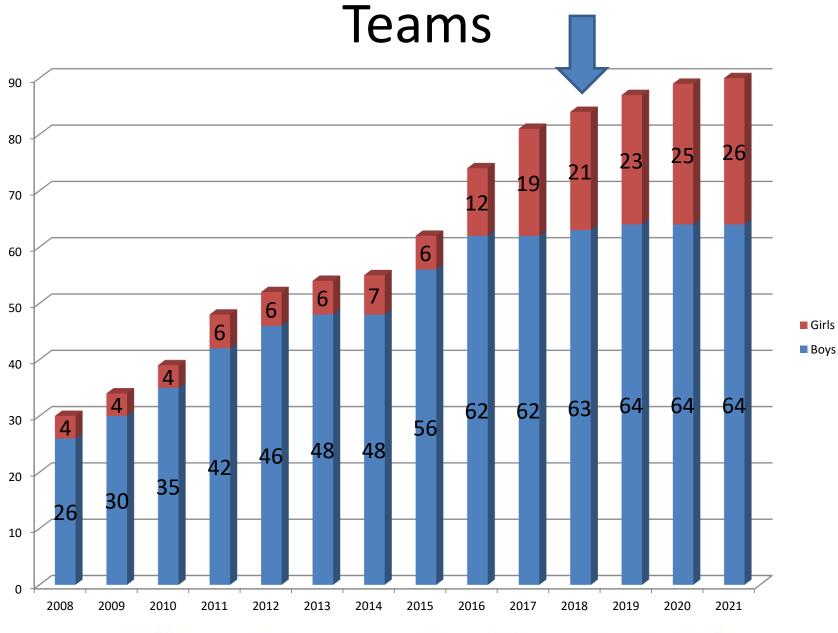

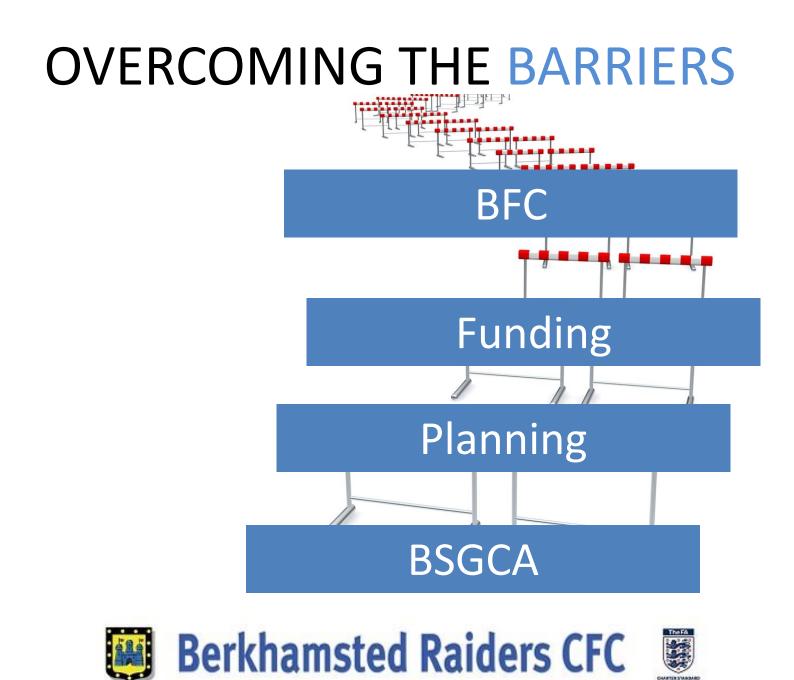
